



Classic Cornice

Cornice can be used on either the standard eaves beam or the super duty eaves beam and is assembled in three sections to add a further degree of elegance to the Classic conservatory roof. Cornice shrouds the existing Classic gutter, in effect hiding the ends of the glazing bars to provide smooth clean lines at the eaves interface.
